Residents enjoy excellent infrastructure, comprehensive public transportation, good quality accommodation, and superior cultural and tourism offerings.</p> <p>Student living costs in Switzerland are comparable to major European cities and are, in fact, lower than those in Paris or London.</p> <p>Living costs depend heavily on personal lifestyles and on one's choice of recreational activities. Based on the experience of former students, CHF 1,500 a month should be available for living a month in Switzerland.
