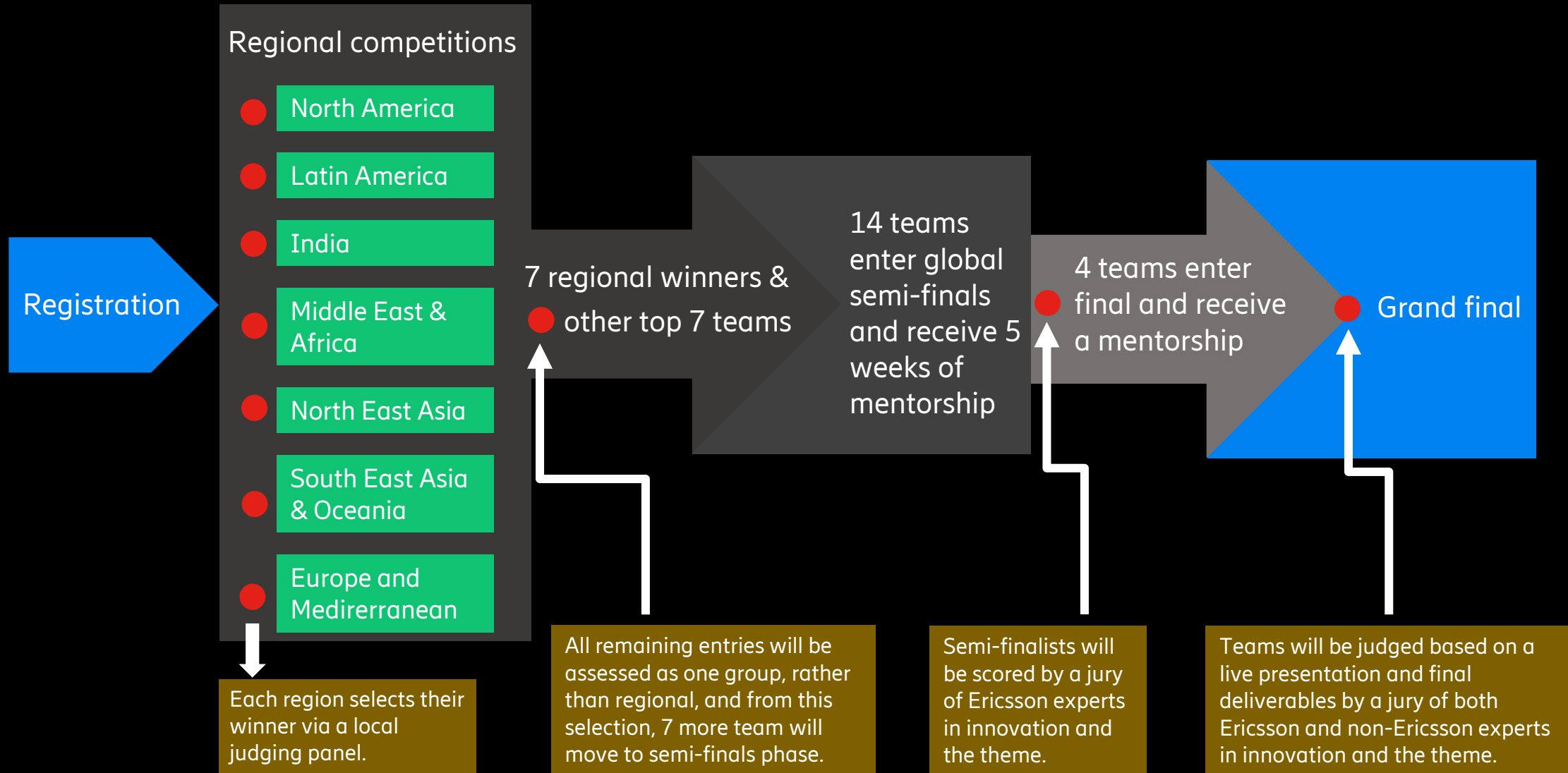
Topic for EIA 2021 : Bridge the digital divide

Eligibility

- **University students**, graduating on or after the end date of the semi-finalist period (September 13th, 2021).

Team size

- **up to 4 total** team members.

Registration

- Names and contact information of team members.
- A full registration is required (in English), including stated problem, customer, solution, innovative aspect, and potential impact.

Prizes and incentives



Semi-finalists:

- Regional winner will receive a cash prize of €1,000.
- Seven weeks of mentorship from Ericsson experts in innovation and business.
- Recognition on Ericsson social and digital media.
- The possibility of Ericsson recruiter interviews (if any suitable positions are available at the time)
- Certificate of achievement

Finalists:

- All three Finalist teams will receive:
