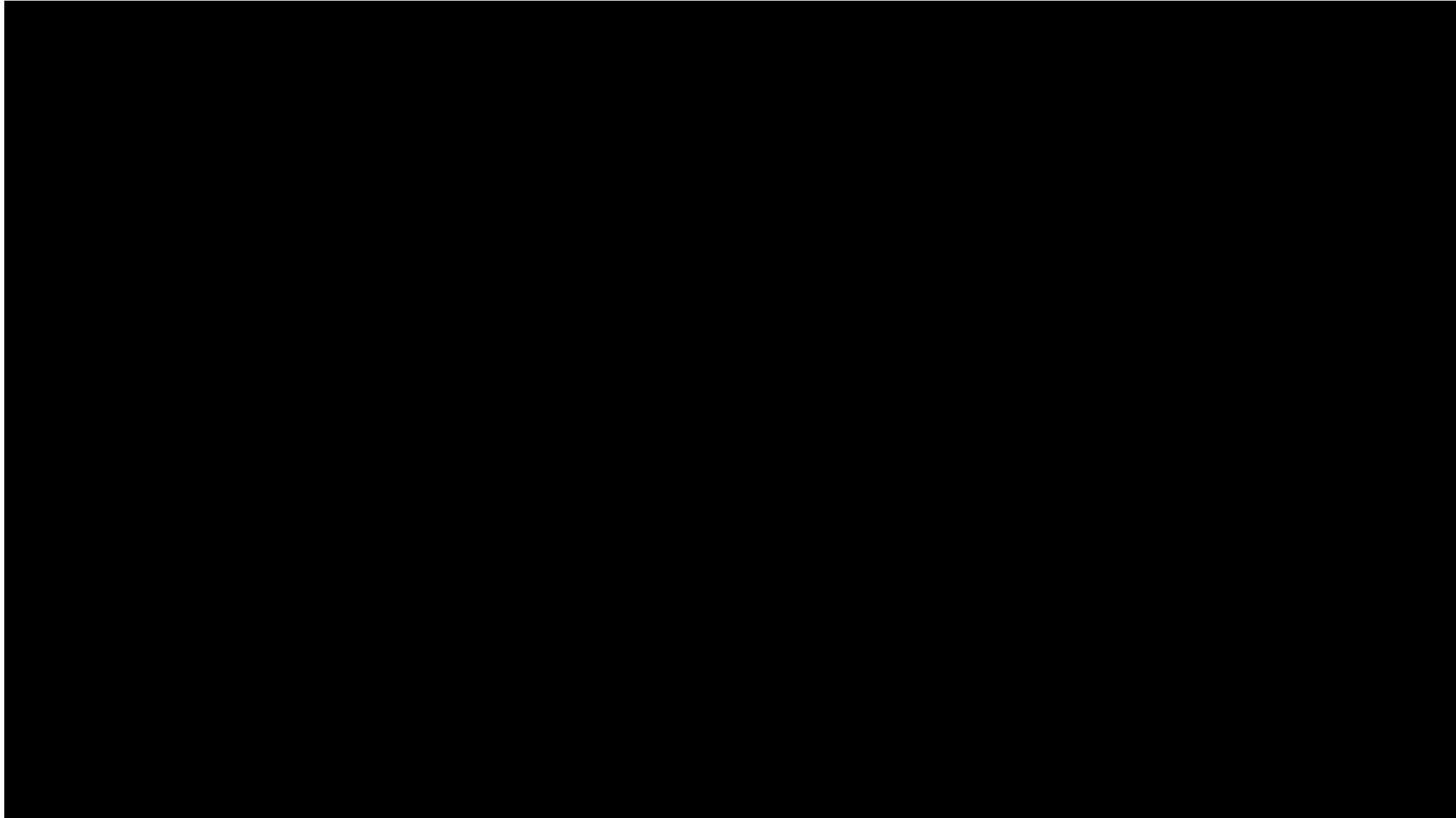
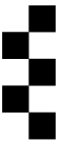
- Britain's oldest recorded town with a 2000 year history

- Restaurants serving food from all over the world

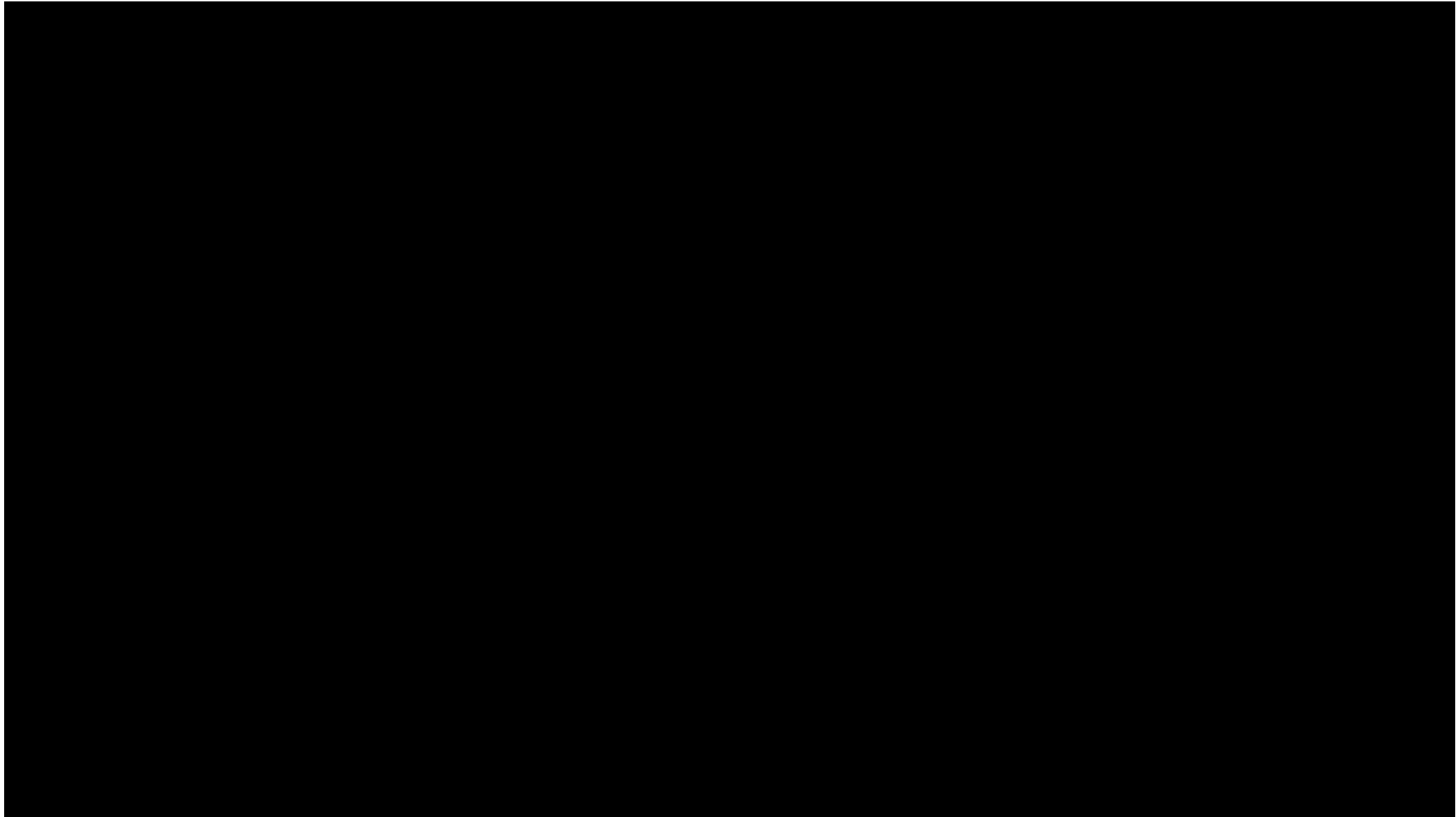
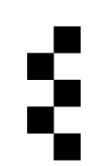

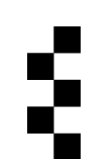
- **Guaranteed accommodation for all new incoming international students** – apply before deadline

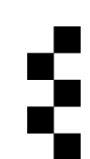

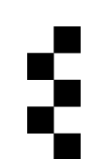

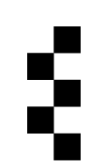
The Forum Building - Southend
