Students coming for a shorter period may need a visa or may be able to enter Italy with a valid passport only, as tourist, depending on their country of origin. Enquire about your specific circumstances at the Italian Consulate near you.</p> ◆ Health Insurance <p>When applying for your visa, you will receive instructions on the health cover you are expected to have for your stay in Italy. If you come for a short period of time and you do not require a visa, it is your responsibility to have insurance that covers you for any accident or emergency during your stay in Milan, including at MIP. If you intend to travel within Europe, make sure that your insurance covers you for the entire Schengen territory.</p>
